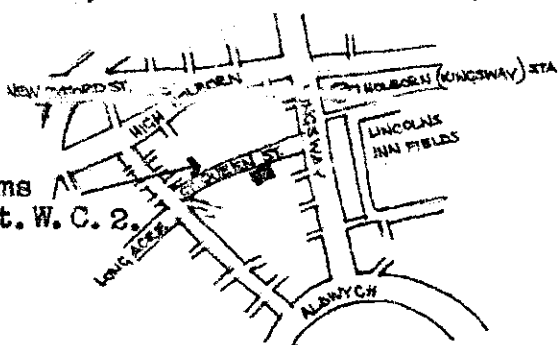
BROTHERS FAREWELL DINNER

Great Queen St. W.C.2.



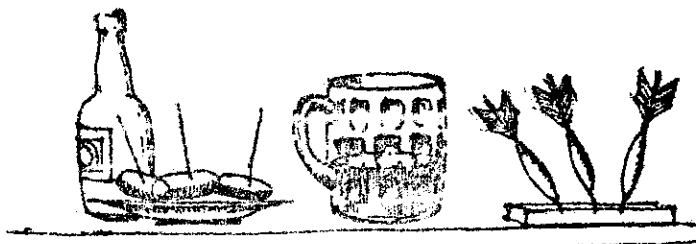
APPOINTMENT OF NEW HEADMASTER
