To the Parents.

The Easter holiday begins on Wednesday, March 28th., and lasts for one week.

Lessons for all the pupils will begin on Thursday, April 5th., at 9-45 a.m.

All classes will attend at the Bishop Fox's School.

There will not be any classes next Term at Clapham College in London.

Boys who have to be re-billeted will be notified by the Billeting Officer when they must return.

The parents are earnestly requested to make sure their sons return to Taunton in time for lessons on April 5th. The billeting problem is very difficult and was made more complicated still after the Christmas holiday by the parents' failure to send the boys back on the day appointed. Failure to comply with school discipline and arrangements results in loss of billets, loss of schooling and unnecessary added burdens to billeting and school authorities.

The reason for this short holiday is two-fold. First, it ensures the minimum loss of billets since one week's absence from a billet does not necessitate the withdrawal of the billeting form with, often, a consequent loss of billet. Secondly, if the war in Europe should terminate within the next month, the school would return to London and we then would be compelled to grant a fortnight's holiday so that we might prepare the College in London for complete school work. In view of the June Public Exams. and of the loss of this fortnight it has been deemed advisable to ensure as much schooling as possible immediately.

I look to the parents to co-operate to the full in these arrangements for what we hope will be the last Term we spend in a reception area.
