Dear Parent or Friend of the School,

For the first time, for many years, we are holding a Summer Fete in the grounds of Clapham College this year on Saturday, 10th July. The object is to raise money towards the construction of new buildings at the College which, as we are sure you all realise, are desperately needed. This Fete must be a great success, socially and financially. To make it so we need your active and generous co-operation. We are therefore asking you to donate, on four fixed weeks, certain articles for the Fete stalls, as follows:-

School week 31 May - 4 June : one article of household goods,
e.g. soap, detergent, brushes, mops, dusters, towels, etc.

School week 14 - 18 June : one bottle of any description
from spirits and wines to squashes, sauces, etc.

School week 21 - 25 June : one packet of sweets

School week 28 June - 2 July : one item of grocery of any type
other than rapidly perishable goods.

Of course, if you can contribute more than one item in any of these categories we shall be delighted, but we do ask every family to contribute one item at least each week.

In addition we ask you to support the Fete by buying lucky number programmes, which you can obtain from the boys. Above all we hope that you will yourselves come to the Fete. Apart from the stalls there will be a fine Tombola, Bingo, many sideshows, refreshments, a raffle and above all, we hope, a happy and cheerful atmosphere.

We shall be sending out reminders as each donation week approaches, through the boys, but our experience is that these circulars do not always reach home. So please keep this letter handy to remind you of the dates.

Please help us to make this new venture a magnificent success. All depends on the support you give us.
